Product rates can always be found on the product label or La Plata County Weed Cards.
Some herbicides are not for use under or close to trees (Milestone). **Always read and follow the label.**
Don't waste your time & money, always calibrate your sprayer before making treatments!
Always add surfactant (Spreader 90 spring/fall, MSO summer).
Rates listed below are suggestions for spot spraying.

Weeds 1 Musk thistle, Kochia

Product Rifle D **Rate** 3oz/ gal @ **spring growth stage** Mow/ pull/ spray before seeding occurs in earlier in June

Weeds 2 Scrub oak saplings (must be under 2 feet)

Product Glyphosate 41% or What you've been using (non selective)

Rate 3oz/ gal @ **fall growth stage**

Weeds 3 Canada thistle and oxeye daisy **Product** Milestone

Rate 1oz/ 10 gallons @ **bud/ fall growth stage**

Site rehabilitation after weeds are controlled- Spraying/ digging, alone, is not effective unless future noxious weeds have competition to prevent further infestations.

If there are few or no competitive plants in the infested area, you may rehabilitate with:

- Dryland pasture mix Low grow mix in early to late November before significant snowfall
 Irrigated grass mix during the growing season when water is available Wildflower mix
